ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4.330.03 OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BYRAM, MISSISSIPPI

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Byram, Mississippi, was adopted in June, 2011, and amended in July, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing to consider amending Section 4.330.03 of the Zoning Ordinance was set for the 22nd day of February, 2018, at 6:00 o'clock p.m.; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Byram, Hinds County, Mississippi, as follows, to-wit:

Section 1

That the matters and facts stated in the preamble hereof are found to be true and correct.

Section 2

Section 4.330.03 CONDITIONAL USES AND STRUCTURES AS

PROVIDED UNDER SECITON 5.600.15 is amended by adding the following subsection:

H. Self-Storage Facility with no drive up access as a Conditional Use of a C-3 Zoned District.

Section 3

The City of Byram, Mississippi, Zoning Ordinance, as previously amended, shall be, and the same is hereby amended to reflect the foregoing change in the text of the Zoning Ordinance from and after thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by this Board.
