"WARNING: Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss, or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities."

- Horses or equine units must be followed by a 'pick-up' person dressed in costume, and must submit proof of liability insurance coverage
- Each contingent with horses must provide clean-up for all waste created by the animals. Waste cannot be left on the streets. Violators will be immediately removed from the staging, parade, or dispersal area and assessed a \$150 clean-up fee
- Children ages 12 and under must be under adult supervision. Applicants are required to ensure the safety of those riding on your parade entry.
- Horses that have a tendency to kick must wear a red ribbon on their tail as a warning sign to others.
- All groups must have a handler on the ground walking the route with the unit. All groups in excess of two horses must have a minimum of two handlers on the ground walking the route with the unit. These handlers are in addition to horseback outriders which participate in the entry.
- Horses will be in front of the fire truck carrying Santa. Horses will need to tolerate the fire siren noise.
